Students are not allowed to bring into the examination room any unauthorized notes, mobile phones or any electronic devices capable of storing and displaying and / transmitting visual, audio or verbal information such as smart watches, digital cameras and mp3 players. If the digital watch worn by students contains features capable of capturing, storing, displaying and / transmitting visual, audio or verbal information, it would be considered an unauthorized device and should not be brought into the exam room.

3. The following is the **Make-Up Examination Policy**:

- Students are allowed to sit for the make-up examination **only if they are absent with a valid medical certificate**.
- Students are expected to be prepared for the make-up examination on the day he / she returns to school. The make-up examination will commence after he / she completes the scheduled examination for that day.
- Students who miss more than one paper will sit for a maximum of two papers per day (including the scheduled paper) in the following order, English Language, Mathematics, Science and Mother Tongue.
- For students who return to school only after the last day of the make-up examination, the examination paper will be given as practice but marks will not contribute to the overall results at the end of the year.
- There will be no make-up for the following: English Language Listening Comprehension and Oral Examination, Mother Tongue Listening Comprehension and Oral Examination. Students will sit for English and Mother Tongue Oral on the same day if he / she returns to school on Day 2 of the oral examination.
