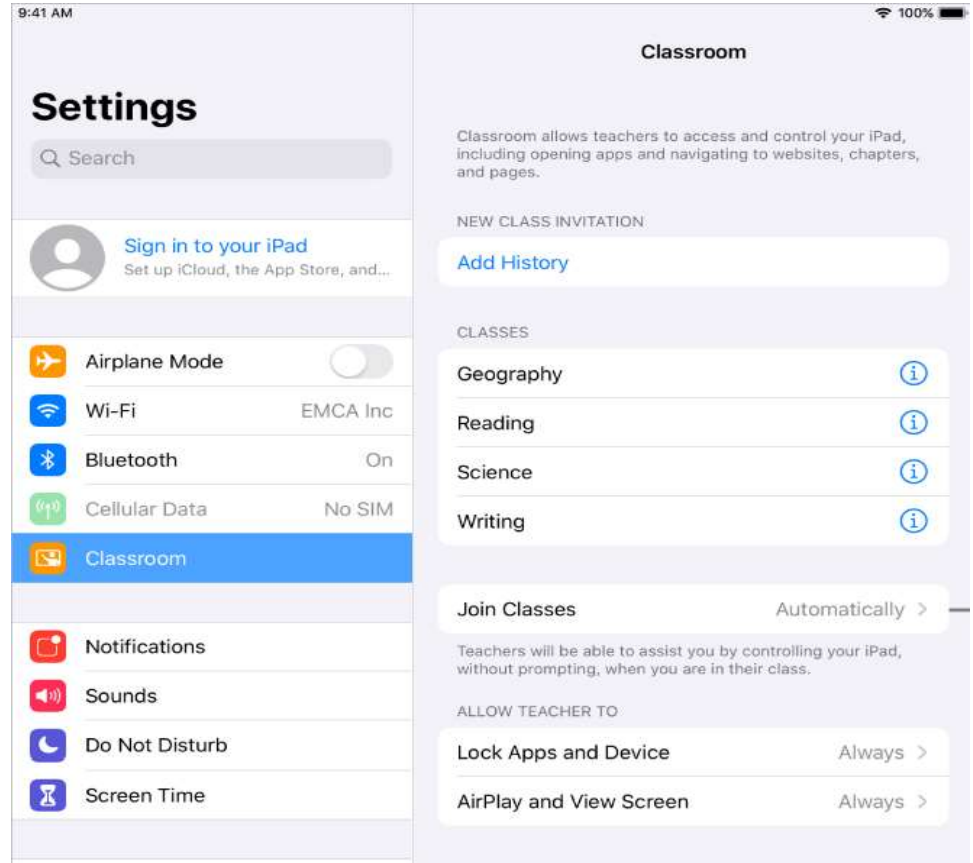

- 1 Mobile Devices and TV not allowed in following areas in our house**  
Bedroom, Kitchen and dining area
- 2 We will not use mobile devices or other screen in the following times**  
While in Car, Family time, meal time and homework time
- 3 We will keep electronic devices switched off at night**  
We will keep these devices switched off, and charge outside bedroom ( In Living Room)
- 4 When we have recreational time, we will:**  
See media together and play video games together
  - We will watch educational shows and apps, use video calls to connect to others
  - We will NOT use media as a baby sitter and spend a lot of time in fast paced noisy videos.
- 5 We will balance online and offline time**  
We will spend time saved from 'online time' to read story books and play outside
- 6 We will follow these digital safety rules**  
NOT give personal information online  
NOT share private photos online

# Parents' role in supporting the use of technology

- Make your own family media use plan.
- It must be made to suit you, your family values and parenting style.
- Treat media as you would any other environment in your child's life.
- Know what platforms, software, and apps your children are using, what sites they are visiting on the web, and what they are doing online.

## (Continuation) Parents' role in supporting the use of technology

- Screen time shouldn't always be alone time.
- Play a video game with your kids. It's a good way to demonstrate good sportsmanship and gaming etiquette.
- Watch a show with them; you will have the opportunity to introduce and share your own life experiences and perspectives—and guidance.



## (Continuation) Parents' role in supporting the use of technology

### Role Model

- Teach and model kindness and good manners online.
- Children are great mimics, plan and limit your own media use.
- Don't use technology as an emotional pacifier.



## (Continuation) Parents' role in supporting the use of technology

- Apps for kids
- More than 80,000 apps are labeled as educational, but little research has demonstrated their actual quality.
- Products pitched as "interactive" should require more than "pushing and swiping."
- Reviews about age-appropriate apps, games and programs to guide you in making the best choices for your children.
- Wise use will allow your child to go along way.





# Not all screen time is equal

- Schoolwork or homework done on screens  $\neq$  total daily allotment
- Quality of the screen time  $\neq$  parent assumes it is
  - Teenagers / adults - socializing is an important aspect of their lives, happens in video games, social media, etc.
  - Judge quality of child's screen time
    - Pay attention to how child responds after various media experiences
    - Ask how they feel about their most-used video games or apps
  - Not fixed, may change over time
