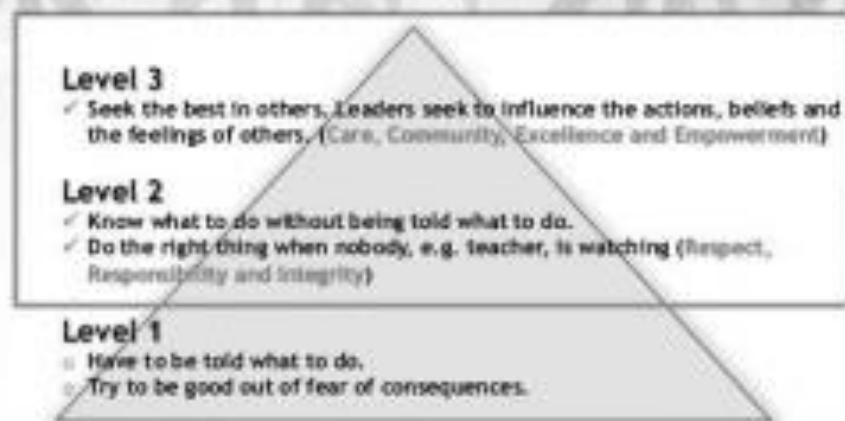


Standard of Conduct (3 Levels of Behaviour)



General School Rules

- 1) Students who are Singapore citizens must sing the National Anthem and take the pledge. Students will take the National Pledge with the right fist over their hearts.
- 2) Students are to wear the prescribed school uniform and modification to the school uniform is not allowed.
- 3) Male students must be neat in appearance and clean shaven. No facial hair is allowed.
- 4) All students are not allowed to have in their possession any weapon. They are also not allowed to bring any weapon-like item which is used or intended to be used to cause harm to others.
- 5) Students are not allowed to leave the school premises during school hours (including lunch break).
- 6) Students must be accompanied by their parents or guardians if they need to leave before dismissal time.
- 7) Students must observe orderliness and exercise self-discipline at all times.
- 8) Students must maintain a neat and clean appearance at all times.
- 9) Students are not allowed to wear jewellery of any form to school. For girls, only small and inexpensive white or black ear sticks can be worn if necessary.
- 10) Students are not allowed to bring toys, electronic games, game cards and other contraband to school.
- 11) Students are not allowed to bring mobile phones to school. Parents will need to inform school in writing for permission to be sought for child to bring mobile phone to school. Once permission is granted, students must lock their phones in the phone lockers located near the General Office. The school will not be held responsible for any loss or damage to mobile phones brought to school. If mobile phone is found in student's possession without school's permission, school can confiscate the mobile phone. Parents will have to come to school to collect it. If student commits an offence involving the use of mobile phone e.g. cyber bullying, accessing or posting inappropriate content, school can confiscate the phone for investigation purpose. Disciplinary action will be taken against the student.

Wear PE Attire (Whole Day)	Students are allowed to wear their PE attire during their CCA session but must change into their school uniform after the session if they do not have a PE lesson that day

General Appearance

Uniform	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• School uniforms should be well pressed, clean and free from any unpleasant odour.• Shirts and T-shirt must be tucked in at all times.• Girls' uniform should be of knee length.• School ties or scarfs (P3 to P6) are to be worn on Monday .• Name tag must be sewn 2cm above the school name / badge on both school uniform and PE T-shirt.
Shoes and Socks	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students are to wear all-black shoes and black socks.• Shoes and socks should be clean.• No sport shoes are allowed unless for special reasons.• Socks should be at least 7cm above ankle.
Hair	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Boys – Hair must be neatly cropped and combed. The back of the hair should cut sloped. No fanciful haircut is allowed.• Girls – Long hair must be neatly tied up or plaited. Only plain black or navy blue clips, ribbons or hair bands may be used.• Fringe must not cover the eyebrows.• No hairdye / tint of any kind is allowed.

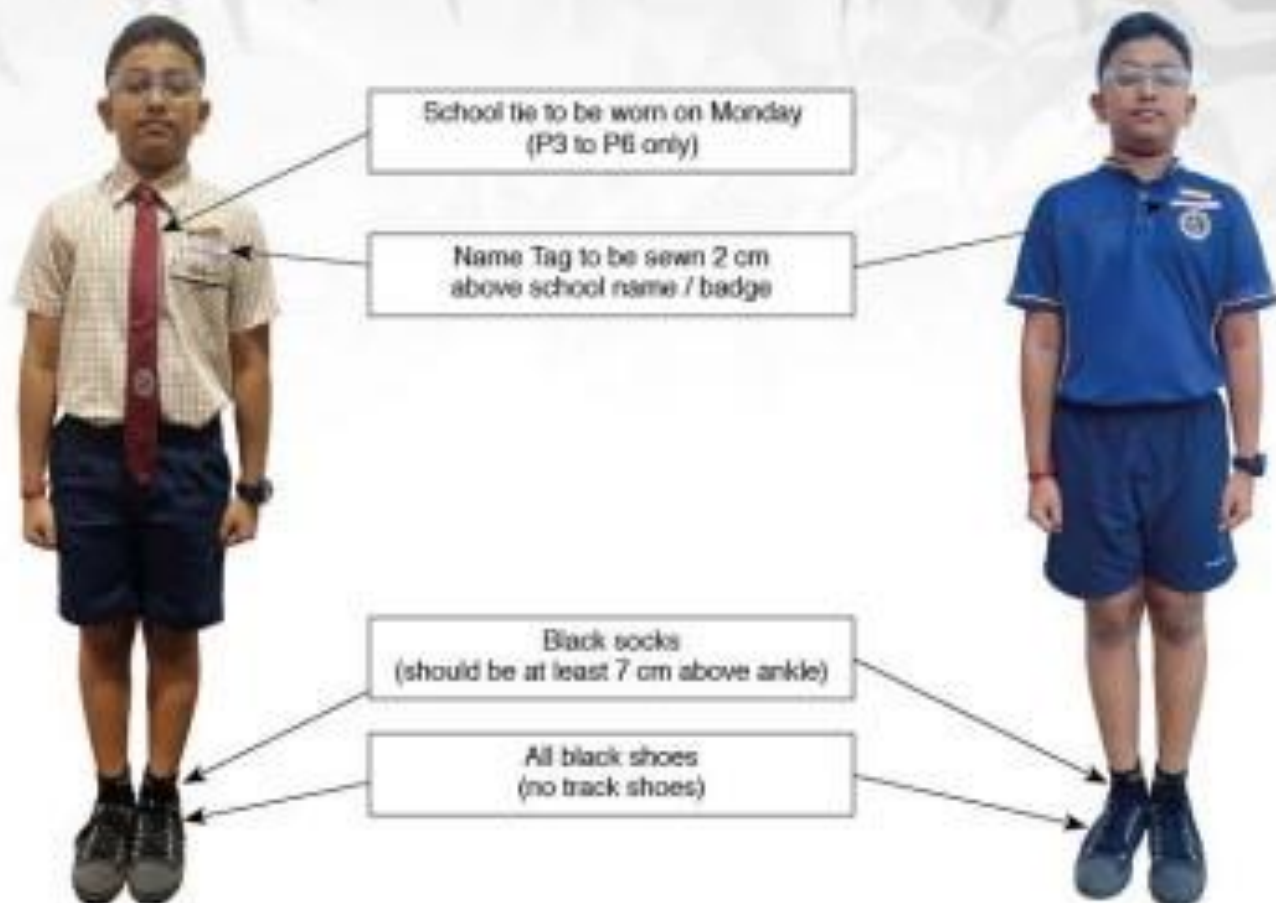


Acceptable Hair Style for Girls
